### **Robbery Suspects in Custody**

Two suspects are in custody after stealing \$400 worth of gift cards and then fleeing the scene. Hollywood Police Officers responded to the robbery which occurred on Wednesday, December 27, 2017 at approximately 11:10 a.m. at the Publix located at 6901 Taft Street in Hollywood.

The suspects entered the Publix store, attempted to fraudulently purchase two gift cards valued at \$200 each. After activating the cards and suspecting credit card fraud, the Publix employee stopped the transaction. While the employee was holding onto the cards, one of the suspects grabbed the cards from the employee's hands. The suspects then fled in a silver Infinity.

Hollywood Police Officers spotted the suspect vehicle and attempted a traffic stop. However, the vehicle continued to flee southbound into Miami-Dade County. The suspects drove into a north Miami-Dade neighborhood and fled from their vehicle on foot. Multiple agencies responded to assist in the search of the two suspects who were both located and taken into custody. Several more gift cards were discovered in the vehicle they were driving.

Curtis Miller and Ricky Charlemagne were arrested and charged with Robbery by Sudden Snatching and Fleeing and Eluding.
