FORT LAUDERDALE -- Construction and maintenance-related lane closures on state highways in Broward County are expected during the week of January 26 through February 2. INTERSTATE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

1.I-95 from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- Three northbound lanes of I-95 will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. The first lane will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane at 12:30 a.m. until 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- Three southbound lanes of I-95 will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. The first lane will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane at 12:30 a.m. until 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Broward County. The scope of work includes adding a lane and converting the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes to create two express lanes in each direction. Other work includes: installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment; widening bridges; and installing noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 Southbound between Broward Boulevard and NW 6th Street, and along I-95 Northbound between Powerline Road and Commercial Boulevard. Cost/Completion: Construction cost is \$149 million. Completion is expected in spring 2020.

2.I-95 from north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale to south of SW 10th Street in Deerfield Beach

Traffic Impact:

- Three northbound lanes of I-95 between Commercial Boulevard and SW 10th Street will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The first lane

will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane at 12:30 a.m. until 5:30 a.m.

- Three southbound lanes of I-95 between SW 10th Street and Commercial Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The first lane will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane at 12:30 a.m. until 5:30 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of Atlantic Boulevard from Andrews Avenue to N. Dixie Highway will be closed Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to westbound Atlantic Boulevard is completely closed through February 2018. Traffic is detoured to a temporary ramp just south of the closed ramp.
- One lane in each direction of Copans Road between North Andrews Avenue and North Dixie Highway will be closed nightly, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- **Sample Road at I-95 will be closed to all traffic** for bridge demolition and construction overnight Sunday through Thursday night between 11 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Eastbound Sample Road traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Copans Road. Westbound Sample Road traffic will be detoured via I-95 and SW 10th Street. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- **Atlantic Boulevard at I-95 will be closed to all traffic** for bridge construction overnight Sunday through Thursday night between 11 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Eastbound Atlantic Boulevard traffic will be detoured via I-95 southbound and Cypress Creek Road. Westbound Atlantic Boulevard traffic will be detoured via I-95 northbound and Copans Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- **I-95 southbound between Copans Road and Atlantic Boulevard will be closed to all traffic** 11 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday, January 28 for overhead sign removal. I-95 southbound traffic will be detoured via Copans Road to N. Dixie Highway to Atlantic Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- **I-95 southbound between SW 10th Street and Sample Road will be closed to all traffic** 11 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Monday night, January 29 and Tuesday night, January 30 for overhead sign installation. I-95 southbound traffic will be detoured via SW 10th Street to Military Trail to Sample Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- Advanced Notice: The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Copans Road will undergo a full daily closure, 5 a.m. until 6 p.m., Saturday, February 3 and Sunday, February 4. Traffic will be detoured via N. Andrews Avenue and Sample Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- Advanced Notice: The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Copans Road will undergo a full nightly closure, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Monday, February 5 through Thursday, February 8. Traffic will be detoured via N. Andrews Avenue and Sample Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard to south of SW 10th Street in Broward County. The scope of work includes adding a lane and converting the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes to create two express lanes in each direction. Other work includes: installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment; widening bridges; and installing noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 northbound between Atlantic Boulevard and Sample Road, and along I-95 southbound north of Sample Road. Contract time for this \$154 million project began **Friday, January 8, 2016**, with

3.I-95 Interchange from Hillsboro Boulevard to SW 10th Street

Traffic Impact:

- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10th Street will be fully closed, as needed, Sunday night through Thursday night between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists can detour via Hillsboro Boulevard.
- The outside lanes of I-95 southbound from Hillsboro Boulevard to SW 10th Street will be closed Sunday night through Thursday night with the first lane closing at 9 p.m., the second lane closing at 10 p.m. and the third lane, if necessary, closing at 12:30 a.m. until 5 a.m.
- Two westbound lanes of SW 10th Street at I-95 will be closed Sunday night through Thursday night between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- The sidewalk on the north side of SW 10th Street between SW 12th Avenue and SW Natura Boulevard is closed through February 2018. Signs are in place to direct pedestrians to the south sidewalk.

Description: Construction on this 1.5-mile project began Monday, January 26, 2015. Work consists of widening southbound I-95 to add an auxiliary lane from the Hillsboro Boulevard entrance ramp to the SW 10th Street exit ramp, widening the existing southbound I-95 exit ramp to SW 10th Street, addition of a free flow right turn lane to westbound SW 10th Street, widening of westbound SW 10th Street to add an acceleration lane, utility relocation, milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, installation of barrier walls, curbs, sidewalks, guardrail, drainage, overhead signs, signing and pavement markings, signals, lighting, and retaining walls. This is the first of five interchange improvement projects throughout Broward and Palm Beach Counties. Cost/Completion: Construction cost for all five projects is \$32.5 million. Completion in spring 2018.

4.I-95 from south of SW 10th Street in Deerfield Beach to south of Glades Road in Boca Raton

Traffic Impact:

- All lane open through Friday, February 2.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from south of SW 10th Street to south of Glades Road in Broward and Palm Beach counties. Scope of work includes widening and converting the existing I-95 HOV Lanes to Managed Lanes which will result in two tolled Express Lanes in each direction; the number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Other activities include reconstruction of I-95 on the northbound and southbound approaches to the Hillsboro Canal bridges, milling and resurfacing of I-95, construction of northbound and southbound auxiliary lanes between Hillsboro Boulevard and Palmetto Park Road, and construction of a northbound auxiliary lane between the SW 10th Street entrance ramp and the Hillsboro Boulevard exit ramp. Other project improvements include: guardrail, barrier wall, attenuators, shoulder gutters, drainage, dredging of Hillsboro Canal, bridge widenings at Palmetto

Park Road and Camino Real, bridge replacement at Hillsboro Canal, temporary and permanent retaining walls, noise wall construction, sign structures, portable traffic monitoring sites, toll gantry installation, Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) installation, signing and pavement markings; Express Lane markers, lighting, ramp metering signals, utility relocation, and landscape relocation.

5.I-75 from NW 170th Street in Miami-Dade County to I-595 in Broward County

Traffic Impact:

Segment A & B (NW 170th Street in Miami-Dade County to South of Miramar Parkway in Broward County)

- Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Miami Gardens Drive to NW 170 Street will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to Miami Gardens Drive will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Miramar Parkway to Florida's Turnpike will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to Miramar Parkway will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from Miami Gardens Drive to Florida's Turnpike will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

- One northbound lane of Florida's Turnpike from I-75 Interchange to Red Road will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- One southbound lane of Florida's Turnpike from I-75 Interchange to Okeechobee Road will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- One northbound lane of Florida's Turnpike from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

- One northbound lane of I-75 from NW 170 Street to Florida's Turnpike will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to NW 170 Street will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Segment C (South of Miramar Parkway to South of Sheridan Street)

- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to North of Miramar Parkway will be closed daily beginning Sunday, January 28 through Thursday, February 1 between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. for median work.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to North of Miramar Parkway will be closed daily beginning Sunday, January 28 through Thursday, February 1 between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. for median work.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Pines Boulevard to North Pines Boulevard will be closed daily beginning Sunday, January 28 through Thursday, February 1 between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. for median or roadway construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Pines Boulevard North of Pines Boulevard to will be closed daily beginning Sunday, January 28 through Thursday, February 1 between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. for median or roadway construction.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Pines Boulevard to North of Pines Boulevard will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. for median or roadway construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Pines Boulevard to North of Pines Boulevard will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. for median or roadway construction.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to South of Pines Boulevard will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 between 8 p.m. and 3 p.m. for median or roadway construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to South of Pines Boulevard will be closed beginning Sunday, January 28 through Thursday, February 1 between 10 a.m. and 7 a.m. for median or roadway construction.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed daily beginning Sunday, January 28 through Thursday, February 1 between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. for median or roadway construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed daily beginning Sunday, January 28 through Thursday, February 1 between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. for median or roadway construction.

- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m. for median or roadway construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. for median or roadway construction.
- One westbound or one eastbound lane of Miramar Parkway from west of I-75 to east of I-75 will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 between 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. for median or roadway construction.

Segment D (South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road)

- The I-75 northbound exit ramp to westbound Griffin Road (Exit 13B) may be closed Sunday night, January 28 through Thursday night, February 1 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists will be detoured to exit at Sheridan Street East (Exit 11), continue east on Sheridan Street to Flamingo Road and north on Flamingo Road to Griffin Road. Please follow the posted detour.
- One northbound and one southbound lane of I-75 from South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road will be closed daily beginning Sunday, January 28 through Friday, February 2 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. as the contractor continues to work in this area.
- Two northbound or two southbound lanes of I-75 from South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Friday night, February 2 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. as the contractor continues to work in this area.
- One eastbound and one westbound lane of Sheridan Street may be closed daily beginning Sunday, January 28 through Friday, February 2 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. as the contractor continues to work in this area.
- Two eastbound or two westbound lanes of Sheridan Street may be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Friday night, February 2 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. as the contractor continues to work in this area.
- One northbound and one southbound lane of I-75 from South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road will be closed nightly beginning Sunday night, January 28 through Friday night, February 2 from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. as the contractor continues to work in this area.

Segment E (North of Griffin Road to I-595)

- Advance Notice: The entrance ramp from eastbound I-595 into the express lanes, located west of SW 136 Avenue, will be closed continuously for seven days from 4 a.m. Saturday, February 3 through 4 a.m. Saturday, February 10. During this time motorists wishing to use the express lanes should continue east on I-595 to the express lane entrance ramp just east of SW 136 Avenue.

Northbound Lane Balancing Project (Indian Trace to I-595)

- All lanes are open through Friday, February 2.

Description: This 15-mile project will add four tolled managed lanes in the I-75 median from NW 170th Street in northern Miami-Dade County to I-595 in Broward County. The work will be completed in four segments to minimize the impact to the public. This project includes entrance and exit access points to the express lanes; a bridge with a direct connection to 595 Express; integrated Intelligent Transportation System and tolling components; noise barrier walls at

NORTHEAST BROWARD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

6.A1A from Oakland Park Boulevard to Flamingo Avenue in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of A1A from Oakland Park Boulevard to Flamingo Avenue may be intermittently closed Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. for lighting restoration.

Description: Project improvements include removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits, upgrading sidewalks and ramps to meet ADA requirements, repairing, adjusting, and replacing drainage structures throughout the project limits, upgrading the following existing intersections to mast arm signals: 34th Street, mid-block between 36th and 40th Street, and at 40th Street, upgrading all existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers, upgrading signs and pavement markings throughout the project limits, including adding a 1.5 foot striped buffer to separate the four-foot wide bike lanes from the outside vehicle travel lane, upgrading existing lighting along the corridor to lighting with a variable intensity function that can be accessed remotely in order to cause minimal disruption to sea turtles during their nesting season, adding elevated roadway lighting and lower level lighting to illuminate the sidewalk, and adding a business access drive aisle along the east side of road between NE 34th and NE 36th Street. Cost/Completion: \$9.3 million / Early 2018

7.Broward Boulevard from NW 18 Avenue to US 1 in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- The sidewalk along the north side of Broward Boulevard between NW 18 Avenue and NW 15 Avenue is closed. Detour signs are in place to guide pedestrians.
- Westbound traffic is shifted slightly north and will use the 3-lane temporary bridge for the duration of construction.
- Eastbound traffic is shifted slightly north to the newly constructed north side of the bridge through early 2018 while crews construct the south side of the bridge.
- Up to two lanes in each direction of Broward Boulevard from US 1 to NW 18 Avenue (500 feet maximum at a time) will be closed weekdays between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. and Saturdays between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. for drainage improvements, widening, curb and gutter installation, and sidewalk construction.
- The sidewalk along the north side of Broward Boulevard from US 1 to NW 14 Avenue is closed for utility improvements. Signs are in place to direct pedestrians to the south sidewalk.
- Access between SW 15 Terrace and Broward Boulevard is closed through February 2018. Detour signage is in place to guide motorists to SW 14 Avenue to access SW 15 Terrace.

Description: Project improvements include replacing the bridge over the North Fork of the New River, removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway, upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements, upgrading signs and pavement markings, relocating bus shelters, adding roadway lighting, installing drainage structures, upgrading signalized intersections to mast arms, reconstructing sidewalks, and widening roadway to add bike lanes in each direction. 8. Hillsboro Boulevard from Military Trail to US 1 in Deerfield Beach

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of Hillsboro Boulevard from Military Trail to US 1 may be closed through January for concrete, sidewalk, drainage, median widening and signalization improvements and sign installation.
- Up to two lanes in each direction of Hillsboro Boulevard from Military Trail to US 1 will be closed nightly between 7:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. through March for milling and resurfacing.
- The outside westbound lane of Hillsboro Boulevard from SE 2 Avenue to US 1 is closed for widening, signalization, and sidewalk improvements on the north side of the road. This lane will remain closed as the final configuration includes two lanes in this segment of Hillsboro Boulevard..
- The inside lane in each direction of Hillsboro Boulevard from east of I-95 to east of Dixie Highway will be closed Monday, January 29 through February for median reconstruction.

Description: Project improvements include improving the off-ramp from northbound I-95 to eastbound Hillsboro Boulevard including adding a new signalized intersection and adding second lane to increase capacity, relocating and upgrading drainage structures, upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements, constructing new stamped asphalt crosswalks from east of Natura Boulevard to US 1, upgrading existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers, upgrading signalized intersections to mast arms, installing new decorative lighting, constructing new medians east of SE 2 Avenue, removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway, upgrading signs and pavement markings to reflect the new roadway configuration as follows: (1) Military Trail to Dixie Highway - Three 11-foot lanes in each direction (2) NE / SE 2 Avenue to US 1 - Two 11-foot lanes in each direction, and adding a bike lane or sharrows in each direction as follows: (1) Military Trail to NW/SW 2 Terrace - 4-foot bike lane (2) NW / SW 2 Terrace to NE / SE 2 Avenue - Sharrows symbols to designate that the outside travel lane will be shared with vehicles (3) NE / SE 2 Avenue to US 1 - 7-foot bike lane. 9. Broward Mobility Project: SW 31 Avenue from Riverland Road to Broward Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- Lane widths on SW 31 Avenue from Riverland Road to Broward Boulevard will be reduced and traffic may be shifted toward the center of the road Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. for signing and pavement markings.

Description: The improvements under this contract include constructing sidewalks, multi-use pedestrian paths, and bicycle lanes along 45 roadways in Broward County within Hollywood, Pembroke Pines, Davie, Plantation, Deerfield Beach, Pompano Beach, Lauderdale Hill, Oakland Park, Lauderdale Lakes, and Fort Lauderdale. Cost/Completion: \$15 million / Fall 2018

10. Old Dixie Highway from NE 13th Street to the south end of the Middle River Bridge in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impacts:

- One lane in both directions of Old Dixie Highway from NE 13 Street to the south end of the Middle River Bridge may be closed weekdays through Friday, March 2, 2018 between 7:30 a.m. and 6 p.m. for resurfacing, roadway widening, and signage and landscaping installation. Flaggers will direct traffic through the work zone. Motorists can expect delays.
- “No Thru Trucks” signs have been installed at both ends of the corridor (NE 13th Street in Fort Lauderdale and NE 11th Avenue in Wilton Manors) to enhance safety now that portions of Old Dixie Highway have been narrowed to accommodate the construction work.
- Lanes widths have been narrowed from NE 14 Place to NE 18 Court. This is a “No Passing Zone”. Use caution when driving through the work zone.
- There is a new traffic pattern in place from NE 14 Place to NE 16 Court because of the new raised intersections, raised crosswalks, and new roundabout at NE 16 Court. Use caution when driving through the work zone.

Description: The improvements under this contract include reducing the width of the travel lanes and modifying shoulders to add 4-foot bike lanes in both directions, constructing sidewalk, drainage improvements, adding roundabout at NE 16th Court, permanently reducing speed limit to 25 MPH, installation of pedestrian lighting, adding landscaping and swales to improve drainage, removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway, constructing 8 raised intersections and 6 raised pedestrian crosswalks and adding new signing and pavement markings.
