



1) All permanent and temporary signs require a permit.

2) The permit is required to be applied for by a licensed contractor except for the following:

Any sign painted on any existing building surface, adhesive sign applied to glass or temporary balloon/banner sign that the work is valued less than \$1,000.00 for labor and material, then the property owner/tenant may apply as the contractor.

This exemption only applies if the sign work IS NOT concurrently part of larger work that is going on with in the property of any kind like repairs, remodeling or alterations.

Application:

Required are two copies of the proposed sign showing dimensions, location on an elevation drawing, location on the property on a survey, attachment details, electrical requirements and other pertinent details required by the City Code and/or the Florida Building Code (High Velocity Hurricane Zone) prepared by the appropriate authority. A current copy of a Certificate of Use for the property is also required.
