On January 6, 2020, The City of Hollywood invites eligible individuals and organizations to apply for a grant of CDBG funds. The deadline for applications is February 6, 2020 at 3:00 p.m. Agencies shall deliver their completed and signed application, along with all requested supporting documentation, to the Community Development Division at Hollywood City Hall, 2600 Hollywood Blvd., Room 203 (Second Floor) on or before the deadline set forth, or the application will be disqualified. There will be an Application Technical Assistance Workshop on January 14, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. at Hollywood City Hall, Room 215 (Second Floor). The City is interested in supporting creative and innovative projects and programs that serve low- and moderate-income (LMI) Hollywood residents.

Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) - this grant funds programs and services in the following areas:

1. Public Services
2. Public Facilities and Capital Improvements
3. Job Creation or Retention
4. Housing
5. Special Activities by an Eligible Community-Based Development Organization (CBDO)
  - a. Neighborhood Revitalization
  - b. Community Economic Development
  - c. Energy Conservation

Proposals will be evaluated by the Community Development Advisory Board and are subject to final approval by the Hollywood City Commission. General Fund grants and Law Enforcement Trust Funds grants are available for agencies that offer other public service programs.
