**Community Resiliency Plan**

The City of Hollywood, Florida anticipates applying for Rebuild Florida General Planning Support Program funding provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to support long-term mitigation efforts by assisting the State of Florida and its local governments in minimizing or eliminating the risks and reducing losses from future disasters. This program is being administered by the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) thru the Community Development Block Grant – Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) Program and \$20,000,000.00 in funding has been allocated for the Rebuild Florida General Planning Support Program. No local match is required to apply for funding.

The City of Hollywood, Florida anticipates applying for a total of **\$6.0 Million Dollars** in funding through the CDBG-MIT General Planning Support Program. In accordance with guidance provided by HUD, the public input requirements for this program include the option to post information about proposed funding projects on a public website with a 14-day public comment period. A copy of this post and any public comments received will be provided to DEO as part of the funding application.
